NCPA's Process

NCPA Works with a public agency, who as Lead Agency competitively solicits national master procurement contracts for use by all public agencies. These contracts are established using the following process:

- The Lead Agency, Texas Regional 14 Education Service Center, issues a competitive solicitation for a product on behalf of NCPA and all public agencies
- The solicitation is advertised nationally for a minimum of four (4) weeks
- The solicitation includes language that makes the contract accessible nationally to public agencies in states who laws allow for intergovernmental contract use (sometimes called "piggybacking" or "adopting")
- Vendors respond to the solicitation with seal responses
- The Lead Agency evaluates the responses and awards contracts
